## **Direct Placement Adoption Requirements**

## • Use full legal names on <u>all</u> documents.

[ ] Verify that the petitioner(s) live in Genesee County or that the adoptee is physically found here
[ ] Filing Fee –

- □ \$186.00 petition fee
- <sup>D</sup> \$50.00 one Michigan Birth Certificate
- <sup>D</sup> \$16.00 for each additional Michigan Birth Certificate (optional)
- If necessary, contact Adoption Deputy Register at (810) 424-4470 to inquire about birth certificate requirements for an adoptee born outside of Michigan.
- [ ] Petition for Direct Placement Adoption (PCA 301a)
- [] Copy of Non-Identifying Information (see #7 on PCA 301a)
- [ ] Certified copy of adoptee's birth certificate (or adoptee's birth verification on hospital letterhead, pending the filing of a certified copy)
- [ ] Copy of each petitioner's birth certificate
- [ ] Copy of each petitioner's driver's license
- [ ] All pre-adoptive assessments/home study reports, including all previously prepared pre-adoptive assessments/home study reports
- [ ] Adoptee's medical report or physical examination results (exam must be dated within one year of filing the petition for adoption)
- [ ] Physical examination results for each member of the adopting family's household (if the member of the household is one year old or older at the time of filing; results and exam must be dated within one year of filing the petition for adoption)
- [ ] Petitioner's Verified Accounting (PCA 347) -- "7-Day"
- [ ] Statement of Services Performed by Attorney (PCA 346) -- "7-Day"
- [ ] Statement of Services Performed by Agency (PCA 345) -- "7-Day"

When a hearing is requested for a parent's or guardian's consent and/or termination of parental rights, the following forms need to be submitted, based on the situation:

- [ ] Parent's or Guardian's Verified Accounting for Adoption Release or Direct Placement Adoption (PCA 348) – One for each available parent or guardian.
- [ ] Social history of child and birth family
- [ ] Consent to Adoption by Parent (PCA 308) <u>OR</u> Consent to Adoption by Guardian (PCA 308a) One for each consenting parent or guardian.
- [ ] Statement to Accompany Consent in a Direct Placement Adoption (PCA 339) One for each consenting parent or guardian.
- [ ] Order Terminating Parental Rights after Release or Consent (PCA 318) One for each consenting parent or guardian.

- [ ] Advice of Rights after Order Terminating Parental Rights (PCA 323) One for each parent or guardian whose rights are being terminated under the Adoption Code.
- [ ] Paternity Clearance
- [ ] Petition to Identify Father (PCA 310) if applicable
- [] Notice of Hearing to Identify Father (PCA 311) if applicable
- [ ] Proof of Service
- [ ] Notice to Putative Father and Custody Statement (PCA 316) if applicable
- [ ] Declaration of Inability to Identify/Locate Father (PCA 315) if applicable
- [ ] Diligent Search if applicable
- [ ] Order Terminating Rights of Father without Release or Consent (PCA 312) if applicable
- [ ] Affidavit Regarding Putative Father's Involvement (Internal Court Form) if applicable
- [] Parent's Consent/Denial form (DHS-1919, 2 pages)
- [ ] Adoption Support Group List
- [] Adoption Information Brochure (DHS Pub 439)
- [] Order Placing Child after Consent (PCA 320) ("TO BE KNOWN AS:")
- [] Notice to Adopting Parents Pending Appeal (PCA 325) ("TO BE KNOWN AS:")

After a placement order has been entered (or within three months of filing the petition for adoption if no placement order has been entered), the following document needs to be submitted:

[ ] First Supervision Report

When the petitioner is requesting finalization, the following forms need to be submitted:

- [ ] Petitioner's Verified Accounting (PCA 347) -- "21-Day"
- [ ] Statement of Services Performed by Attorney (PCA 346) -- "21-Day"
- [] Statement of Services Performed by Agency (PCA 345) "21-Day"
- [] Final Order Allowing Fees (PCA 341) ("TO BE KNOWN AS:")
- [] Order of Adoption (PCA 321)
- [ ] Public Information Form
- [] DCH-0854 (Prepared by the Court, signed by the petitioners)
- [] Second (usually final) supervision report -- request finalization
- [ ] Affidavit to Court on pending Appeal/Rehearing
- [ ] Request for DVD/Copy Form with \$20.00 fee, if a DVD is requested
